Arrival by Airplane

You can reach the Airport Nuremberg (Flughafen Nürnberg) from all over the world. By car it takes you 20 minutes from the airport to University Hospital Erlangen.



Arrival by Train

The central station at Nuremberg (NUE) is one of Germany's most important railway intersections. It provides express train connections to all European metropolises every hour. From Nuremberg to Erlangen it takes you 20 minutes by regional train.

The university hospital is situated within walking distance to the station.

Arrival by Public Transport

The public transport in the area of Nuremberg and Erlangen is excellent.

From Airport Nuremberg or Nuremberg main railway station to the ISI

- Subway **U2** (right outside the terminal) to Nuremberg main railway station (Nürnberg Hauptbahnhof)
- Train **S1** (going to Forchheim or Bamberg) to Erlangen main railway station (Erlangen Hauptbahnhof)
